\$15.00	Individual	Shall be eligible to register for Club activities. Individual members over the age of eighteen (18) shall have the right to vote and hold office.
\$20.00	Family	For persons living at the same address. They shall be eligible to register for Club activities. A maximum of two adult members shall have the right to vote and hold office, but only one member of a family may hold office at any given time. Each handler in a family must pay grounds fees (e.g. 2 handlers x \$75 = \$ 150).
\$10.00	Social	Shall be for individuals and families who wish to maintain contact with the Club through the Club Newsletter. Social Members shall not be eligible to register for Club activities. They have no voting privileges and may not hold office.

2016 Volunteer Commitment Form

Unlike other agility organizations that aim to make a profit, have a payroll and charge high fees to train, CAC St. Lazare is a non-profit club organized and run by its members for the benefit of all. In return for the lower fees and to keep the Club viable, it is essential to continue making volunteer commitment a required element of active membership in the Club. As previously, family and friends may help members fulfill their obligations.

Again this year we will be hosting an AAC and a CKC trial. Each trial requires a half-day of set up and runs a full weekend.

Each member training a dog is required to work at least:

- a) **ONE FULL**-day of classes (Saturday or Sunday) at **either** trial or
- b) **TWO HALF**-days (Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday) at either trial.

Note: Half-day setup may only be chosen once.

A full day of classes means that if there are eight classes you are volunteering during all eight from first to last dog in each class. Lunch will be provided. A half-day would mean you are volunteering for four classes that day. **You cannot volunteer for classes in which you are running your dog.** Set-up will be on the Friday afternoon before the trial, starting around 1 pm.

Enclosed is a brief description of what is required for each volunteer assignment. Please read it before making your job selection. If you are not sure how you can best help, or need further information before you complete and sign your form, please bring it with you to the Annual General Meeting **on April 8th**. The Board members will be happy to offer guidance and answer any of your questions.

Please note that as with all agility clubs that are not run as a business, one full day of volunteering at trials is a requirement in order to be eligible for membership the following year. Every attempt will be made to accommodate your choices but failure to fulfill the volunteer requirement will lead to refusal of future club membership.
